Dear Mr. Barney,

The Rhode Island Army National Guard (RIARNG) is providing you this notification in accordance with Condition 2(d) of the January 26, 1993 Transfer Agreement for Camp Fogarty, East Greenwich, RI between the Department of the Navy and the Department of the Army. Condition 2(d) of the agreement requires the Army to provide 60 days prior written notice of any construction or similar activities at Camp Fogarty which may affect any activities required under the Navy's March 23, 1992 Federal Facility Agreement with the Environmental Protection Agency and Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management. The RIARNG is planning a FY 11 MILCON project for Training Area-3D, a former Navy range at Camp Fogarty. Training Area-3D, a portion of the RIARNG's operational range area, was closed in 2009 pursuant to completing the MILCON project. The project consists of constructing a \$21 million United States Property and Fiscal Office. Contract award is anticipated in October 2010, with the groundbreaking scheduled for November 2010.

The RIARNG has contracted with Dawson Technical, LLC to perform a Site Inspection of Training Area-3D at Camp Fogarty to assess the potential for releases of munitions and explosives of concern from use of the area as a former range by the Navy. The Site Inspection is being conducted under the auspices of the Military Munitions Response Program (MMRP) with technical assistance from Ms. Kim Hartz of the National Guard Bureau.
