The purpose of this letter is to transmit my additional comments on the subject document. The Navy has proposed a no action at these sites. As discussed in the June 16, 1994 meeting, this should be changed to limited action at site 5 and could be a no action at site 8. For the Limited Action of Deed Restrictions for the industrial/commercial future use at Site 5 (& at Site 8, if the Navy still proposes it) the Proposed Plan must evaluate the remedy according to the 9 criteria as required by the NCP. This evaluation could be included in the proposed plan, instead of generating an additional document.

I look forward to discussing with you the schedule for release of the final proposed plan, the public hearing and the release of the draft and final ROD at these sites.
