Pursuant to §7.6 of the NCBC Federal Facility Agreement (FFA), the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the above referenced document. Comments are as follows:

1. The location of the leach pit must be at least 50 to 100 feet west of the MW 20 well cluster so there is no possibility that the integrity of the revetment along the shore is questioned and must be positioned away from the daily "clean trucking" traffic road.
2. The effluent of the drum washing activities should be kept to a minimum.
