This Division has reviewed the above cited document and agrees with the recommended proposed action of removal and off-site disposal of contaminated soil, debris and "asphaltic" materials. The Division looks forward to the rapid restoration of these areas.

Based on discussions occurring on 26 July 1995, the State and EPA were informed by Navy representatives that the proposed action would not in fact be undertaken for Site 10, Camp Fogarty Disposal Area. Be advised that Rhode Island General Law 23-18.9-5 prohibits the abandonment of a quantity of solid waste greater than three (3) cubic yards. Portions of the Camp Fogarty Disposal Area would be subject to regulation under this law. The Division has provided the Navy with copies of this and other relevant environmental laws and regulations; however, if you are in need of a copy of this particular law, I would be happy to provide one for you.
