As a result of delays with interpretation of the large volume of groundwater data, the Navy proposes a modification/extension of subject document for Site 16 at NCBC, Davisville, RI. This modification/extension is requested for the purpose of finalizing the Remedial Investigation activities of Site 16 for the primary purpose of characterizing the source area and extent of Volatile Organic Compounds in ground water.


