The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has reviewed the above referenced document. The Department finds the work plan to be acceptable with the condition that the following comments be addressed:

1. Section 4.5.2.3, Sediment and Soil Criteria, page 4-30


Table 4-7 is incomplete. Reference is made in the narrative of this section to the Toxicity Characteristic Leaching Procedure (TCLP). The criteria presented in Table 4-7 are EP Tox data, not TCLP data. A new table containing the TCLP data must be generated.

2. Section 5.5.1, Site 4, Table 5-9

Previous reports have indicated that Base/Neutral/Acid compounds (BNAs) have not been detected in monitor well 4-3. Table 5-9 shows BNAs detected at 100 ug/l. Please generate a corrected table.
