Site 8 Investigation Work Plan


The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has reviewed the above referenced document. The work plan is approved contingent upon the following comments being addressed.

1. The NJDEP must be notified two weeks in advance of the planned date for field activities.
2. The NJDEP reserves the right to modify the specific locations of the test pits at the site contingent upon field observations.
3. Continuous field screening of the soils and the pits must be included in the work effort. All HNU/OVA readings must be documented in the field.
4. The sampling plan must include the capability to collect a minimum of one aqueous/leachate sample per pit. The need to collect such samples will be determined in the field during the test pitting operations. If ground water is encountered in the test pit enough should be allowed to infiltrate the pit to obtain a sample. Any aqueous/leachate sample collected will be analyzed for the same parameters as specified for soils in the plan.
