RE: WAYSIDE AREA ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

Gentlemen:

Pursuant to my letter of 10 June 1991 and our meeting of 11 June 1991, the following plan of action has been devised to alleviate any potential environmental threat to the Wayside Area of Naval Weapons Station Earle:

1. All electrical transformers have been tested; 43 are non-PCB and 5 are PCB contaminated (less than 500 ppm). Removal of these transformers is scheduled to commence on October 1991.
2. Removal of 3 underground No. 2 fuel oil tanks will begin in November 1991. These tanks are registered.
3. Two aboveground tanks will be removed as soon as possible.
