This is a follow-up to our telephone conversation on November 12, 1991 regarding the third round of sampling at NWS Earle.

As we agreed, representatives of Versar, Inc. will take split samples on, December 2 and 3, 1991 at: site 2, wells 3 and 5; site 10, well 5; site 5, wells 7 and 8; site 3, well 5 for routine analytical services; and, site 2, well 3 for special analytical services. If possible, all sampling should be done in one day.

Also, I received your letter dated November 18, 1991, responding to my August 28, 1991 letter regarding the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's comments on the data validation for the first round of sampling. However, your letter did not include the responses. Could you please send them to me.
