

This letter is in response to the February 29, 1988, letter from FMC Corporation (FMC) and the March 2, 1988, letter from the U.S. Navy (Navy) regarding the responsibility for maintenance of ground water monitoring well information. The Navy's letter indicated that FMC will maintain all ground water monitoring records ". . . once FMC's overall contract for operation of the NSD Plant has been revised to include this task."; whereas FMC's letter stated that ". . . The Government (Navy) will maintain these (monitoring well) records until the completion of the ground water remedial action at which time these records will be assigned to the contractor (FMC) for retention as well as any subsequent records that are generated." It is apparent to Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff that there is some confusion as to when FMC will maintain and be responsible for the ground water monitoring well records for the facility. Therefore, please re-evaluate this information and submit to the MPCA the correct FMC/Navy contract language and/or requirements for storage of the ground water monitoring wells within 15 days upon receipt of this letter.
