As requested in your letter of 5 August 1988, the U.S. Navy, FMC Corporation and the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers have agreed upon a proposal for maintenance of ground water monitoring well records on-site at the FMC facility.

Under this proposal, the Corp of Engineers will transfer past monitoring records to FMC Corporation, Naval Systems Division, 4800 East River Road, Minneapolis, not later than 1 October 1988. Subsequent records will be forwarded to FMC within seven days of receipt by the Corp of Engineers. Monitoring records will consist of well logs, analytical results and water level readings.
