Dear Counsel:

Enclosed for your review, please find a copy of the most recent draft of the Federal Facility Agreement for the Naval Industrial Reserve Ordnance Plant Fridley, Minnesota. I am also enclosing a copy of a letter dated March 8, 1991 from me to EPA Region V regarding the few remaining changes to be made to the document. Let me call your attention to the following provisions: paragraph 5.1 (Statutory Compliance/RCRA-CERCLA Integration), paragraph 31.1 (Stipulated Penalties), paragraph 33.1(2) (Extensions), Section XXXVIII (Force Majeure), and the proposed State reimbursement provision.

Because there is arguably a statutory deadline, pursuant to 42 U.S.C. section 9620(e)(2), sometime near the end of this month for this agreement, I would appreciate your comments, if any, as soon as possible. I appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
