The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff has reviewed a copy of the monthly log from C.S. McCrossan, Inc. indicating that 600.04 cubic yards of soil were removed from NIROP and thermally treated by C.S. McCrossan, Inc. on August 2, 1993. This soil was the Category II soil from the construction of the Hazardous Materials Storage Building at NIROP. The MPCA staff has reviewed the post-burn analysis from C.S. McCrossan, Inc. for the thermal treatment of the soil and the results indicate that the soil has been adequately treated.
