Please find attached two copies of the Draft Field Sampling Plan (FSP) for the NIROP Fridley Anoka Park Investigation. The FSP was developed from the outcomes of the Technical Committee meetings, in Pittsburgh, Charleston, and Fridley. The Technical Committee Meetings established the big picture of the Anoka Park investigation, i.e., where to install wells and what the goals are. Consistent with the Partnering team consensus, an expansive FSP was not developed for this exercise. This FSP is necessary, however, to provide the 'nuts and bolts' including the drilling and sampling methods, analytical methods, and number of samples. Where possible, the FSP references back to the OU3 Work Plan (QAPP, FSP), and the RAWP.

An updated Health and Safety Plan is included as an appendix to the FSP, primarily because the OU3 work was predominantly indoors, while the Anoka Park work will be outdoors, and different hazards are presented by each environment.

We suggest that you provide the second copy of this FSP to Mr. Cliff Casey.

We understand that the Partnering Team is excited to begin this work. Therefore, we anticipate that the document review by team members will be expedited. Since the plan has been thoroughly previewed at the various meetings described above, we are optimistic that a two-week (ending August 13) review period is possible. We will be contacting Anoka Park soon to ensure that they are onboard with the team's plans.
