Attached, please find Navy responses to MPCA comments on the Revised OU3 Remedial Investigation Report, August 1999. These comments were provided in the November 17, 1999 letter from Michael Kanner to Joel Sanders. The Navy had issued this report as final by virtue of addressing MPCA and EPA comments received on the Draft OU-3 report. Subsequent to delivery of the Revised Report, the MPCA letter substantially altered the risk assessment narrative.

The November 17 letter also suggested that additional risk assessment comments could be forthcoming. On January 4, MPCA notified the Navy that there would not be any additional comments. This resulted in an extended period during which many of the outstanding issues were discussed and resolved between our staffs and us via phone, email, and at Partnering Team meetings.

MPCA's original letter is lengthy, and so we have attached it to these responses rather than re-typing it entirely. Also attached, please find a December 6 email from myself to you, which is referenced in one of the responses.

Upon the MPCA's agreement with these Navy responses, the agreed revisions will be incorporated in the report.
