
On March 1, 1996, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) reissued a hazardous waste facility permit to United States Navy-Naval Sea Systems Command and Armament Systems Division of United Defense, L.P. for hazardous waste storage and corrective action at solid waste management units at the Naval Industrial Reserve Ordnance Plant and the Armament Systems Division Plant in Fridley, Minnesota.

The MPCA terminates this permit effective immediately.

As background information, the MPCA approved closure of Storage Area C of the facility on November 5, 1997. On February 4, 1999, the MPCA approved closure of Storage Area E. On March 24, 2003, United Defense, L.P. and the MPCA entered into a Corrective Action Agreement.
