The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff has reviewed the document entitled, "Work Plan for Supplemental RCRA Facility Investigation," dated September 30, 2004, which was submitted pursuant to the Corrective Action Agreement between the MPCA and United Defense, L.P., dated March 24, 2003, by email message on November 5, 2004.

The MPCA staff hereby approves the work plan with the modification identified below.

## **Section 2.1, Field Activities, pages 2-3**

A decision as to the placement of a permanent monitoring well or wells will be determined based on an analysis of the data collected in Stage 1. It is possible that more than one permanent monitoring well will be required to monitor the Former Paint Shop plume. It is possible that the down gradient plume is present at more than one interval. The MPCA staff requests that the work plan be modified to state that a permanent monitoring well or permanent monitoring wells will be installed rather than a permanent monitoring well based on an analysis of data collected in Stage 1.
