The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA or Agency) is in receipt of the Final Electrical Resistance Heating (ERH) Treatability Study Report for Site 22, Former Building 105 Old Dry Cleaning Facility, Naval Station Great Lakes. The report was drafted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. on behalf of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command (Navy). It was dated January 2008 and was received on January 23, 2008. Included with the final report were Navy responses to Agency comments on the Draft ERH Report. The Agency has reviewed the Navy's responses to comments and the final document and has no further comments at this time.

Provided the Navy addresses the soil and groundwater issues according to the information provided in this report and in the already-submitted Proposed Plan, Closure of Site 22 (Building 105) relative to both soil and groundwater under the CERCLA program and the RCRA program should be considered complete once the Final Record of Decision is submitted and the appropriate institutional controls are established. The Agency cannot provide an official closure letter for this site at this time. Illinois EPA can only provide a closure letter for this site once the Final Record of Decision has been submitted, reviewed, and approved.
