
In late 1986, Congress passed the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) (PL 99-499) which requires departments, agencies and instrumentalities of the Federal Government to comply fully with the requirements of the Superfund program. The Superfund program mandates reporting of releases to the environment of hazardous substances and conducting response actions to clean up hazardous waste sites caused by past disposal practices. One of the Act's requirements is to develop a Technical Review Committee (TRC) to review and comment on proposed actions to clean up contaminated sites. This committee must include representatives from federal and state regulatory agencies along with local government and community representatives.

Your office was very helpful in participating in the Naval Amphibious Base, Little Creek's (NAB) first TRC meeting on January 10, 1989. We would like to meet with you at our next TRC meeting, which will be held in conjunction with the Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command at 9:00 a.m. on February 5, 1992 in the Pleasure House Room of the NAB Little Creek Officer's Club.

A copy of the Interim Remedial Investigation Report for the sites under investigation is enclosed. These findings will be discussed at the meeting. We request that you provide any written comments on this report no later than February 21, 1992 if you are unable to attend the TRC meeting in person. Please contact Anne Marple at 363-4846 by January 29, 1992 to advise us whether you will attend.
