To Restoration Advisory Board Members:

Naval Amphibious Base (NAB) Little Creek is pleased to announce the next Public/Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting on Thursday, September 3, 1998. The meeting will start at 1:00 p.m. in the "Sandpiper" conference room on the second floor of Drexler Manor BOQ, Building 3408. Parking will be available in front of the building in the BOQ residents' lot (see the enclosed map). From the front door, the stairs and the elevator are to the right. On the second floor, the conference room is across the hall from the elevator, and to the left of the stairs.

The topics that will be discussed include the following:

1. Site 7 Remedial Action
2. Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for Site 13 Removal Action
3. Sampling of Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs)
4. Impact of National Priorities Listing (NPL)
5. Ongoing sampling at Sites 11, 12, and 13
6. Optional Site Visits

Both the Draft Final Closeout Report for the Remedial Action at Site 7 and the EE/CA for Site 13 Removal Action will be available for review in August. The Draft Final Project Plans for sampling at SWMU 3 and Site 8 is enclosed for those RAB members who requested a copy. The Executive Summary is enclosed for the remaining members. The document is also available for review in the information repositories and at NAB Little Creek.

The Federal Register Notice announcing the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) intention to place NAB Little Creek on the NPL should be published soon. The impacts of being listed will be discussed. As discussed in the last meeting, extensive sampling is ongoing at Sites 11, 12, and 13. The results will be briefly discussed. More information will be available in early 1999 when the report of the sampling will be available.

At the conclusion of the meeting, there will be an opportunity to visit some or all of the sites depending on participation. If you are interested in visiting the IR Sites, please call Kelly Greaser at 462-4571 by August 21 so we can reserve enough vehicles.
