Review of the *Draft Site Investigation SWMU 7 and SWMU 8*

Dear Ms. Hayes:

The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ), Office of Federal Facilities Restoration has completed its review of the *Draft Site Investigation SWMU 7 and SWMU 8* dated October 2000. Based on this review, VDEQ offers the following comments on the subject document:

1. Section 5.3.1, SWMU 7: Based on the information presented in the SI and summarized in this Section, it appears that localized areas of inorganic and PAH contamination are present at SWMU 7 in the vicinity of CB 125 and Piers 52-55. It is VDEQ's recommendation that the site boundaries for SWMU 7 be revised to include what is currently considered the western portion of the site (i.e. - Intercove Road westward) and a Remedial Investigation be conducted at SWMU 7 to include a quantitative human health and ecological risk assessment to further evaluate potential risk from areas of localized contamination found at the site.
