5.2 Directions and Hospital Routes

5.2.1 Site 5

The following are directions to Sentara Bayside Hospital from Site 5:

1. Leave site, turn left. Proceed southeast on Murray Road.
2. Turn left (east) onto Amphibious Drive.
3. Turn right (south) onto D Street and proceed through Gate 5 to exit Base.
4. Continue through Gate and head straight (south) onto Independence Boulevard.
5. Hospital is on the left side, approximately 5 miles south on Independence Boulevard.

5.2.2 Site 9

The following are directions to Sentara Bayside Hospital from Site 9:

1. Leave site, turn left. Proceed south on Hewitt Drive.
2. Turn left (east) onto Gator Boulevard.
3. Turn right (south) onto D Street and proceed through Gate 5 to exit Base.
4. Continue through Gate and head straight (south) onto Independence Boulevard.
5. Hospital is on the left side, approximately 5 miles south on Independence Boulevard.

5.2.3 Site 10

The following are directions to Sentara Bayside Hospital from Site 10:

If on west side of site:

1. Leave site, turn left. Proceed south on Helicopter Road.
2. Turn left (east) onto Amphibious Drive.
3. Turn right (south) onto D Street and proceed through Gate 5 to exit Base.
4. Continue through Gate and head straight (south) onto Independence Boulevard.
5. Hospital is on the left side, approximately 5 miles south on Independence Boulevard.

If on east side of site:

1. Leave site, turn right. Proceed south on Hewitt Drive.
2. Turn left (east) onto Gator Boulevard.
3. Turn right (south) onto D Street and proceed through Gate 5 to exit Base.
4. Continue through Gate and head straight (south) onto Independence Boulevard.

5. Hospital is on the left side, approximately 5 miles south on Independence Boulevard.

5.2.4 Site 11

The following are directions to Sentara Bayside Hospital from Site 11:

1. Leave site, turn right. Proceed south on E Street.
2. Turn left (east) onto Gator Boulevard.
3. Turn right (south) onto D Street and proceed through Gate 5 to exit Base.
4. Continue through Gate and head straight (south) onto Independence Boulevard.
5. Hospital is on the left side, approximately 5 miles south on Independence Boulevard.
