Foster Wheeler Environmental Services (FWES), as part of the Baker Environmental Inc. (Baker) Team, is pleased to submit two copies of the draft Feasibility Study (FS) for Site 7, Amphibious Base Landfill, for your review.

The FS has been prepared using the data obtained during the 1993 Remedial Investigation (RI), and the most recent discussions held between FWES, Baker, LANTDIV, and NAB Little Creek. The FS will be further modified, once we receive:

- Comments from LANTDIV and NAB Little Creek;
- Results of the Ecological Study at NAB Little Creek conducted under CTO-0328; and
