On behalf of Winoma Johnson, U.S. Navy NAVFAC, Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. (TtNUS) is providing this letter to document the completion of an emergency removal action to minimize exposure to contaminated soils at the recreational vehicle camping park (RVCP) portion MRP Site 1, Former Carr Point Shooting Range, located at Naval Station Newport.

On May 26, 2010, 640 linear feet of 6 foot chain link fence was installed by a fence contractor under TtNUS supervision to limit access to the western portion of the RVCP. Fence posts were installed by either direct push via a pneumatic hammer or set in concrete footings completed by a power auger. A second general service contractor completed the auger holes with HAZWOPER trained personnel. Line posts were secured with drive anchors and 6 inch galvanized chain link fence was completed with top and bottom coil wire. Soil cuttings generated during augering were consolidated and disposed in the Tank Farm 4 investigation derived waste (IDW) roll off container.

At the request of the Navy, the final fence design did not include an open corridor to provide beach access and, in addition, excluded an additional portion of the northern former firing arc area. Gates located on the existing west fence were secured with locks and chain to prevent access from the beach into the excluded portion of the site. The enclosure contains photographs taken of the installed chain link fence.




