

Dear Mr. Frye:

DESC's contractor, Tetra Tech EC, has completed the attached Draft Site Investigation and Remedial Action Report for Tank Farm 3. As you know, DESC initiated the work described in the attached report to identify and remediate areas of the concern on the subject property that are related to DESC operation of the tank farm since 1974. In our efforts we have addressed several areas that likely existed prior to DESC's involvement dating back to the construction of the tank farm based on aerial photographs including locating and cleaning the sand filter pit. In addition an attempt was made to reduce levels of contamination during remediation efforts to below the RIDEM Residential Direct Exposure Criteria for your future redevelopment of the site. DESC was only obligated to clean up to Industrial Commercial Criteria based on current site usage.

The areas described in the report, which remain above the RIDEM direct exposure criteria, are below the applicable industrial commercial criteria or are areas identified prior to 1974 and DESC's involvement with the site. Tank and pipeline cleaning and inspection were performed and documented in 2002. It is expected that the Navy will complete any additional requirements for site closure during the decommissioning of the site infrastructure.
