1. Our contractor, Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation (FWEC), plans to remediate petroleum contaminated soil, and potentially limited quantities of contaminated groundwater, around seven former underground storage tanks that were located adjacent to Building 44 (former pump house) on Gould Island. Authorization from the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM), Division of Site Remediation, is forwarded as enclosure (1). A coastal zone consistency concurrence from the Rhode Island Coastal Resources Management Council (RI CRMC) is forwarded as enclosure (2).

2. All equipment and personnel will be transported to the island by barge; however, we must first repair the steel sheetpile bulkhead. We are requesting written authorization to conduct the necessary repairs as a Category I project under the Rhode Island Programmatic General Permit (RI PGP, Permit No. GP-57). A description of work and drawings are provided for your review as enclosure (3).

3. FWEC also plans to install a floating dock system at Gould Island and Derektor Shipyard, Newport, RI. At each location ten 6' by 20' sections will be linked together to form a 30' by 40' dock. Plan and section views are forwarded as enclosure (4). Dock access will be via an aluminum ramp with handrails.

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These docks will provide access for site personnel to and from
the island as required.
