RE: Phase II Remedial Investigation Work Plan for Naval
Submarine Base New London

Dear Ms. Keating:

The Navy is in the process of awarding the contract to implement the Phase II Work Plan for the remedial investigation at Naval Submarine Base New London. The work plan was developed by Atlantic Environmental Services but the Navy will use its CLEAN contractor, Brown & Root/Haliburton NUS, to perform the work. This switch in contractors will require that an addendum be added to the work plan to show changes in personnel and laboratory. We anticipate minor changes to the Health and Safety Plan such as providing a list of health and safety training, and correcting the list of authorized site personnel to reflect NUS' team. Similar straight forward changes will be made to the work plan, field sampling plan and the quality assurance plan. The only significant change proposed is to use Southwest Laboratory of Oklahoma, Inc. in place of National Environmental Testing Inc., Cambridge Division.

Contractually, the Navy can not submit the complete addendum until several weeks after contract award because it requires a certain level of effort by NUS, however, the lab quality assurance plan can be submitted at this time. The target date for initiation of fieldwork is August 4, 1993. To assist us in meeting this date, I am requesting that EPA review the Quality Assurance Manual for Southwest Laboratory of Oklahoma, Inc., which I have enclosed, prior to receiving the complete addendum package.
