DEP has reviewed the Navy's revised responses to DEP's January 27, 2010 comments regarding the Remedial Investigation Update/ Feasibility Study for the Area A Wetlands. The Navy's original response to DEP's comments was dated February 1, 2010, and was provided to DEP in an e-mail dated February 17, 2010 from Aaron Bernhardt of TetraTech.
