Dear Ms. Kuntzleman:

This is to inform you that we have reviewed your application to place approximately 6,579 c.y. of clean aggregate fill landward of an existing retaining wall and to place approximately 85 c.y. of riprap along the base of the seawall at the Navy facility on the Thames River at Groton, CT. Of the fill, 4,705 c.y. over an approximate area of 7,425 s.f. is waterward of the high tide line. The purpose of the fill and stabilization is to construct a secure controlled industrial facility on the navy site.

Based on our review of the information you provided to us or the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection, Office of Long Island Sound Programs (CTDEP OLISP), we have determined that your project will have minor individual or cumulative impacts on the waters and wetlands of the U.S.. **We hereby authorize your project under the Connecticut Programmatic General Permit (CT PGP, Permit No. 41).** The expiration date for this authorization coincides with that of your State approval. The CT DEP OLISP issued a Tentative Determination #199801839 - GW for this project on April 16, 1998.

Please note that the activity must be performed in compliance with all the terms and conditions of the CT PGP. Enclosed is a copy of the permit requirements. Please review it carefully to thoroughly familiarize yourself with its contents. You may wish to discuss the conditions with your contractor to ensure that the work can be accomplished in a manner that conforms to all requirements.

If the plans or construction methods for work in our jurisdiction need to be changed, please contact us immediately to discuss modification of this authorization before they are undertaken. Changes which affect work within our jurisdiction must be approved by this office.

Also, this permit requires you to notify us before beginning work and allow us to inspect the project. Hence, you must complete and return the attached Work Start Notification Form to this office no later than two weeks before the anticipated starting date. Also note that this determination does not constitute an authorization to proceed until all other applicable Federal, state and local permits are obtained.

Performing work not specifically authorized by this permit, starting work without obtaining other Federal, state and local approvals, or failing to comply with the permit conditions may subject you to the enforcement provisions of our regulations.
