Hi Mark.

I was going through the March 1983 Initial Assessment Study (IAS) today and it raised a few questions.

The activities at the base and the wastes generated from those activities listed in Table 6.3-1 are consistent with the contaminants that were detected at the Goss Cove Landfill as part of the Phase I and Phase II Remedial Investigations. Page 10 of the IAS states that only incinerator ash and inert rubble was dumped at the site. It is therefore not clear why so many contaminants were detected as part of the Phase I and Phase II Remedial Investigations. Could you please explain this to me?

Could you please respond to these questions and the March 9, 1998 letter before the upcoming EPA/Navy RCRA meeting? Thanks a lot. I think it will help us have more meaningful discussions.
