Dear Mr. Krivansky:

This office is in receipt of the Draft Sampling Plan Addendum to conduct additional groundwater sampling for the Building 31-Lead Remediation Project. Upon review of this document, and based on our telephone conversation this day, this office has the following comments:

- (1) the Sampling Plan Addendum does not include any provisions for the measurement of turbidity during groundwater sampling. This should be included and the levels (NTUs) specified.
- (2) the Sampling Plan Addendum briefly discusses that both unfiltered and filtered samples will be collected. However, the methodology for collecting the filtered samples is not addressed in the Standard Operating Procedures.
