Comment 1. Section 2.4 ? Site 23: Has the final decision been made on whether or not LP-20 moves forward as a CERCLA site?

RESPONSE: Site 23 is now considered to be a CERCLA site, thus the discussion will remain in the report..

Comment 2. Section 3.3: By what process/policy/guidance does the Navy determine that 20 is the adequate number of interviews that would be representative of the community?"

RESPONSE: Twenty community members agreed to participate in the interviews. Over 30 community members were contacted; however, we did not receive a response from all the people we attempted to contact.

Comment 3. Section 4.2.8: According to the Federal Facility Agreement Proposed Plans should have a 45 day public comment period.
