Dear Mr. McCoy:

Section 104(b)(2) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) requires the notification and coordination of Federal and State natural resource trustees with regard to potential damages to natural resources resulting from release of hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants or constituents.

In addition to the responsibility to investigate and clean up Navy-administered hazardous waste sites, the Secretary of Defense has been delegated specific responsibilities under CERCLA as a trustee for natural resources. Investigations under the Navy's Installation Restoration (IR) program are underway at Naval Base Norfolk and a Technical Review Committee (TRC) has been established for review and comment on the IR program activities.

As the State of Virginia's representative on the TRC for Naval Base Norfolk, we ask that you coordinate review and comment applicable to TRC activities with all appropriate State of Virginia agencies, including the natural resource trustee(s).
