Dear Ms. Romanchik:

We wish to meet with you to discuss comments contained in your letter of October 7, 1991 regarding our Building LP-20 and Building V-28 Closure Plans. We feel that some of these comments are inconsistent with agreements made during enforcement order negotiations.

As discussed in an October 22, 1991 telephone conversation between Ms. Cheryl Finley of your staff and Ms. Sharon Waligora of this office, a meeting has been set for November 4, 1991 at 10:00 a.m. in the Monroe Building. In order to facilitate a productive meeting, we request that members of your staff such as Karol Akers, Steve Frazier and Ron Smith, who were involved in Enforcement Order negotiations, attend. We are preparing a list of issues for discussion at the meeting and will provide it to you upon completion.

Also, as discussed in the October 22, 1991 telephone conversation, we request the 30-day deadline for submission of revised closure plans be rescinded and a revised schedule agreed upon during our meeting on November 4, 1991.
