Re: Naval Base, Norfolk CD Landfill, Permit No. 286

Dear Mr. Kowalski:

On February 10, 1993, you inspected the CD Landfill and noted specific areas of noncompliance with Virginia Solid Waste Regulations. In response to your March 9, 1993 letter, we submitted an anticipated schedule of corrections to the landfill.

Your recent follow up inspection on June 9, 1993 confirmed our significant progress while noting some areas that still need corrective measures. In response to your June 29, 1993 letter, the following updated schedule and progress summary is provided:

a. February 10, 1993 Inspection Letter Items:

1. Site Drainage ditch improvements are complete. Side slope grading on the lower fill areas is complete. Side slope grading on the upper fill areas is approximately 40 percent complete. Grading of the remaining upper fill areas should be complete by August 1, 1993.

2. All trees have been removed from the fill areas.

3. Grass and weed cutting has been completed.

4. Leachate outbreaks on the fill surface have been repaired. Any additional ruts produced will be corrected as they occur.

5. The disclosure statement has been submitted.

b. Groundwater Monitoring System Letter: Monitoring well sampling was completed on July 1, 1993. Testing results will be forwarded to Virginia Department of Environmental Quality upon completion (scheduled for August 1, 1993).

c. Disclosure Statement Letter: A disclosure statement was forwarded to VDEQ on May 21, 1993.
