Dear Pete:

It was good to be with you at the recent meeting of the Glenwood Park Civic League.

Many of the residents as a follow up to that meeting have inquired as to the possibility of doing some soil sampling in the Glenwood Park area to determine whether or not these toxic substances have permeated the soil in the Glenwood Park area and not just limited to the water supply and to the aquifers under the soil.

Accordingly, on behalf of the residents of Glenwood Park, I would inquire as to whether or not the city and/or the state either individually or together would agree to conduct some soil sampling tests at various locations within the Glenwood Park area to determine whether or not some of those toxic substances have permeated the soil in the area. I would certainly hope that the city and state health departments would give this matter top priority so as to alleviate the concerns of all of the citizens and residents of the Glenwood Park area. I would be happy to try and help or provide assistance in any way possible.
