Dear Mayor Leafe:

Under the Installation Restoration Program, we have formed a Technical Review Committee (TRC) which comments on proposed actions regarding potential hazardous substance releases on the Naval Base. The TRC is currently comprised of Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Virginia Department of Waste Management representatives, as well as two members from your staff, Mr. John Kmiec and Mr. Lee Rosenberg.

The Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act, which established the TRC requirement, also stated that a citizen should be a member of this committee. In 1988, you nominated a citizen who has since moved from the City of Norfolk. The purpose of this letter is to request you nominate another citizen representative to the TRC.

We appreciate your assistance and look forward to continuing to work with your representatives to ensure community concerns are addressed in our investigations and cleanups. Our point of contact on this matter is Ms. Cherryl Barnett at 444-3009.
