1. Throughout the document, disposition of the rinse- and wastewaters generated in the on-site water treatment facility is referenced. Is the WWT mentioned the existing WWT at the Norfolk Naval Base, or the one that is intended to be built at the Camp Allen site. Does the referenced WWT have a permitted discharge, or discharge to HRSD? please elaborate.

2. In Section 5.1, Drum Management, handling of investigation derived wastes is discussed. As has been discussed previously with Mr. Ken Walker of LANTDIV, containerized IDW has a 90-day accumulation time limit whether the waste is hazardous or non-hazardous solid waste in accordance with the Virginia Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Regulations. Please observe this accumulation period.
