**NOTICE OF NAVY'S INVITATION
FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE
Proposed Remedial Action Plan
Site 22 Camp Allen Salvage Yard
Naval Station Norfolk**

The Department of the Navy (DoN) invites public comment on the Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) for Installation Restoration Site 22 Camp Allen Salvage Yard, located on Naval Station Norfolk. The PRAP identifies and discusses the preferred alternatives to address contaminated soil and sediment at Site 22.

In accordance with 40 CFR 300.430(f)(2), the assessment of risk information as related to both human health and the environment is detailed in the PRAP for Site 22. The PRAP includes a summary of preferred remedial alternatives for Site 22. The preferred alternatives are: Soils – Institutional Controls Plus Land Use Control Planning; and Sediment – Institutional Controls Plus Land Use Control Planning.

The PRAP is based upon the findings of previous site-related documents contained in the DoN's Administrative Record for Naval Station Norfolk. The Administrative Record can provide you with important background and site investigation information about Site 22. The Administrative Record and the PRAP are located for public review at the following location during normal business hours:
