In response to your recent request, representatives of the BTAG have completed the review of the subject document. The proposed scope of the sampling investigation appears to be appropriate given the investigative activities that have been completed to date. However, there is no indication that the requisite evaluation of potential impact of site contaminants on ecological receptors has been, or will be performed. While the available information suggests that it is likely that there are no, or limited, exposure pathways to ecological receptors, the necessary information must be documented in an appropriately scaled ecological risk assessment.
