Enclosed are two copies two hardcopies of the documentation for finalize the *Focused Feasibility Study for SWMU 14, Q-50 Satellite Accumulation Area, Naval Station Norfolk, Norfolk, Virginia* (CH2M HILL, June 2009). Covers, spines, and the title page are being provided to document the change from draft to final, as well as sections 1 and 3, Table 3-1, B-3, B-4, and B-6. The revisions in the text were completed to reflect comments received from United States Environmental Protection Agency, Virginia Department of Environmental Quality, and US Navy legal review. The following changes were made to the text:

- Section 1.4: The vertical component of vertical migration should be addressed. The last sentence of the paragraph was revised to "...limiting contaminant transport through the subsurface."
- Page 17: "NCRTA" was revised to "NTCRA."
- Section 3.2.2: Was revised to include "and prohibit the use of groundwater."
- Section 3, page 5: A paragraph was included to describe the costs associated with maintenance (but are not technically part of the LUC alternative).
- Table 3-1: The Alternative 1 time frame was revised from > 70 years to 30 years.
- Table B-3. Narrative about the CZMA was revised to state "will be consistent to the extent practicable with the enforceable policies of the State's coastal zone plan."
- Table B-4, the Chesapeake Bay Preservation Act was revised from "applicable" to "relevant and appropriate."

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- Table B-6. The Virginia Erosion and Sediment Control program was revised to "relevant and appropriate" from "applicable."
