
We appreciate the opportunity to speak with you and the other members of the EPA staff last week. The phone call was a productive information exchange, and was very useful in communicating site-specific data efficiently and effectively. Similar verbal discussions should be considered in the future before written comments are provided to expedite the Corrective Action Process. Lantdiv is currently completing the response to comments and should provide this response by early October.

EPA raised several questions during the phone conversation concerning Phase II activities and the overall status of the IR Program at NAS Oceana. Chapter I of the Phase II Report provides an overview of field activities for all the sites, and is submitted for your review. The Site Management Plan is being updated and will be submitted for your information by early October at the latest.

Although the Phase II RFI report is only in the draft stage, we would appreciate your comments, especially with regard to sites 2D and 25 where no further action except monitoring is recommended. However, please note that data from additional fieldwork currently ongoing could change the Conclusions and Recommendations at sites 2E and 15.
