
Please find enclosed four copies of the subject document. As stated in Section 1.2 *Investigation Objectives*, the Phase III RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) was conducted to fulfill data gaps identified during the review of previous RCRA reports documenting the investigation of the Naval Air Station (NAS) Oceana solid waste management units (SWMUs). The Navy's response to comments on these RCRA reports and the findings of the Phase III report support the determination of no further action (NFA) required at 11 NAS Oceana SWMUs (SWMUs 2D, 11, 16/16CG, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 25, and 26). The NFA determination for these 11 SWMUs was based primarily upon human health risk and consideration. Therefore, the Navy will utilize the RCRA reports to support the NFA determination for risk to human health at these 11 SWMUs and will further evaluate ecological concerns at all NAS Oceana SWMUs within the ecological risk assessment (ERA) process.

Appropriate record of decision documents will be prepared for the closure of these 11 SWMUs. Each Record of Decision or Decision Document will address the NFA determination for risk to human health as documented in the RCRA reports, and the results and action required at the completion of ecological risk assessments.
