Dear Mr. Sokolowski:

The Navy and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) agreed to conduct future site remediation activities at Naval Air Station (NAS) Oceana following the procedural and substantive requirements of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) program. The parties agreed that a Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) would be negotiated for NAS Oceana, which is not on, or proposed to, the National Priorities List (NPL).

Enclosed please find the Navy's proposed non-NPL FFA for NAS Oceana, which would also supercede the existing Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) 3008 (h) consent order. This document tracks substantially with the FFAs we have done in Region III. Please have your staff review and let us know of any issues we will need to discuss.
