By letter dated July 1, 1992, Naval Air Station (NAS) Oceana informed your office of our intention to remove soil from an oil stained area located near Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) No. 20 of the current Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation (RFI) workplan for NAS Oceana. However, soil analyses indicate there is more extensive soil contamination present than previously anticipated. Therefore, we intend to further delineate and address this contamination during the RCRA Field Investigation (RFI) of SWMU 20.
