Enclosed please find the Site Closeout Report for Site 17 - Firefighting Training Ring, NALF Fentress, Virginia for your information and evaluation. Per your letter dated January 9, 1995 and our telephone conversation on 1 February 1995, this document should provide the necessary information you requested. I have also enclosed a letter from Biosystems technology Inc., that discusses average loading rates of the microbial/nutrient solution.

As I mentioned in our telephone conversation, the groundwater data from the Site Investigation report indicated that no VOC or BTEX constituents exceeded federal MCLs. The Navy considers that this fact coupled with removal of the potential soil source alleviates any requirements for future groundwater monitoring at the site.
