Dear Mr. Garnett:

Based on a recent review of the Preliminary Assessment (PA), EPA Form 2070-12, approved for Marine Corps Recruit Depot (MCRD), Parris Island, South Carolina on September 1, 1984, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) concurs with the recommendation for further pre-remedial action. The necessity for Site Inspections (SI) at MCRD Parris Island warrants medium priority due to the possible contaminant migration associated with historical waste management practices at this facility. Accordingly, SI information should be used to develop a well documented Hazard Ranking System (HRS) pre-score package. To allow enough time for EPA quality control analysis before the statutory April 18, 1989, National Priority List proposal deadline, SI and HRS pre-score packages should be submitted no later than October 15, 1988.
