Dear Mr. Harrington:

Personnel with the S.C. Department of Natural Resources (SCDNR) have reviewed the Proposed Plan for Soil Interim Remedial Action at Site/SWMU 3, and agree that it would substantially reduce site risks to terrestrial ecological receptors. We further believe that addressing the most contaminated sediments adjacent to the causeway, through "limited sediment excavation or covering", as part of the slope stabilization and erosion control measures, would substantially reduce site risks to aquatic ecological receptors. Provided these areas of sediment remediation are those agreed to by the Partnering Team in our conference call on June 5, 2000, and documented in drawings C-16 through C-19 of the Draft Design Submittal, the SCDNR would concur that the Proposed Plan constitutes an adequate interim remedial action.
