The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Marine Corps Recruit Depot (MCRD) have requested concurrence from the Division of Waste Management of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) concerning the corrective action for SWMU 3. The Department understands that the corrective action is to include: covering the landfill with 2 feet of soil, stabilizing the banks to prevent erosion, and covering the four sediment hotspots adjacent to the landfill with a geotextile cover. Additionally, it is understood that the MCRD desires to construct a roadway along the causeway landfill.

The Division of Waste Management is responsible for ensuring compliance with all RCRA requirements and guidance pertaining to corrective action. As such, the Division of Waste Management perceives the proposed corrective action as an appropriate interim measure. Consequently, this correspondence may be viewed as an approval of such interim measure. Please be advised that the final corrective action for SWMU 3 will be deemed complete upon adequately addressing the potentially contaminated sediments beyond the proposed cover.
