Hi Tom - I checked with Dave Brayack on issue number 1. Dave said he suspects we're mixing up two different issues. Precipitation moisture will not pass through the membrane. However, the construction method to install the membrane does have to be able to allow some push or pull from tidal influence near the toe-in of the membrane in the marsh. This avoids a failure at low tide, when pent up higher water level behind the membrane would seek release.

For issue number 2: Someone circulated an attendance sheet. I don't have a copy. If someone could forward that to me electronically, I'll distribute that to the Team. Note that the TRC minutes already calls out the affiliation of team members. But besides TRC, I don't currently know the affiliation of TRC members.

Couple of comments on the TRC minutes.

1. "Mr. Armstrong asked if moisture would pass through the membrane, and David Steele said no." This response appears contrary to what we've heard before. During the Site 1 design phase, the team was told by TT that moisture *would* pass through the membrane. The trustees were concerned that diurnal tidal exchange may leach landfilled contaminants back to the marsh. Have the characteristics of the membrane changed or have I taken something out of context?
2. It would greatly help to identify the affiliation of the individual questioners. Either a

roster of attendees or an in-text notation of their affiliations would satisfy this uncertainty.
